## Doc 02 SAGTA 'Contribution to Geography Award'

The SAGTA 'Contribution to Geography Award' recognises the significant contribution\* of the nominee to advancing geography as follows:

- Contribution to the development of geography in southern Africa
- Teaching and mentoring that impacts on the teaching profession
- Contribution to promoting the importance and value of geography to the public

\*The definition of contribution includes service to SAGTA, outstanding teaching and mentoring that impacts on the profession and outreach that communicates the importance and value of geography to the public.

#### **Number of Awards**

- There is no limit to the number of awards in this category.
- SAGTA reserves the right not to select any recipients for a particular year if the evaluations performed indicate that nominations do not meet the stated criteria.

### Eligible

- Must be a SAGTA member in good standing
- Must be registered with SACE.

#### **Not Eligible**

 An application which has either be awarded or has been previously nominated for the SAGTA 'Contribution to Geography Award'.

#### **Nomination Procedures**

Nominations must be sent electronically to <u>secretary@sagta.org.za</u> and must be received by the application deadline.

- One **proposer** shall be designated with whom SAGTA will communicate regarding the nomination.
- This award requires a seconder to also sign the award nomination form.
- The proposer does not require SAGTA affiliation.
- The proposer shall submit the SAGTA Contribution to Geography application document addressing each of the criteria in two pages or fewer and listing the relevant criteria title and description at the top of each page.
- The proposer shall ensure that all documentation is accurately completed and submitted. Incomplete nomination packages will not be evaluated.

# **Nomination Package Content**

The nomination package shall contain:

- The SAGTA Contribution to Geography Award document addressing each of the criteria that must be met (no more than 2 pages per criteria).
- SAGTA Award Nomination Form
